Information for parking and lunch

By train to Honiton and then taxi to St Rita's Centre. Fare costs about £3.60/£3.80. It is advisable to book a taxi in advance - Aries Taxis on 01404 549892.

Bus Nos. 389 and 387 stop outside the Holy Family Catholic Church in Exeter Road. Turn left by the church into Ottery Moor Lane and follow the signs to St Rita's Centre.

Car to Honiton- for your navigation system our post code is EX14 1AP-

from the west, A30, take the slip road signposted to the town centre, turn left at the main road junction, straight on at the mini round-a-bout (Catholic Church on your left) take the 1st turning left and follow the signs to St Rita's Centre. There is plenty of car parking space. If you come on St Rita's Day, please follow the directions of the traffic marshalls.

From the east, A30, take the slip road to Honiton, right at the first junction, straight on to next junction turn left, go to next junction which is mini round-a-bout, follow signs to town centre, drive through the town, as you start to drive up hill leaving Honiton behind you, be prepared to indicate right, the right hand turning into Ottery Moor Lane is at the top of the hill. You will see the Catholic Church on your left as you turn into Ottery Moor Lane. Follow signs to St Rita's Centre.

Lunch

Food is not provided so please bring a packed lunch. I have been advised that there is a sandwich bar and shop called Rainbow within 3 minutes walk of the venue, turn left when you leave the centre, or ask Brother Terry for directions
